- IQAC, in association with the Research Development Committee, organizes seminars/ workshops on Research Methodology for the students as well as teachers every year.
- Webinar/ seminars are organized on Intellectual Property Rights for the teachers as well as students.
- Teachers are encouraged to present research papers in the national/ international seminars.
- Teachers are encouraged to publish research papers in the UGC CARE listed journals.
- MoUs are signed with the training and placement agencies in order to train and facilitate the placement of students.
- Academic audit is conducted to assess and enhance the effectiveness of teaching methods, administrative processes, and support services.
- Surveys and feedback forms are used to gather insights from students, faculty, and staff. The feedback is analyzed to identify areas for improvement and implement necessary changes.
- Professional counsellor has been appointed who takes care of counselling the students in times of their psychological, personal problems affecting studies apart from regular sessions on time management and stress management thus ensuring their academic and personal development.
- Career guidance and placement support programs have been strengthened to improve student employability and career prospects.
- Teaching learning facilities are regularly upgraded to create a conducive learning environment.
- The adoption of new technologies like Google Classroom, Google Meet, Microsoft Teams, Google forms and other ICT tools is encouraged among teachers.
- The IQAC has been actively involved in preparing documentation and evidence required for assessments by NAAC.
- Continuous monitoring of compliance with accreditation standards and regulatory requirements has been undertaken to ensure that the institution meets and exceeds quality benchmarks.
- ISO certification has been initiated.

- **Faculty Development:** Increased faculty participation in professional development activities has led to improved teaching methodologies and research output.
