**A Report on the Seminar on
Outcome Based Education and NEP-2020**

As the college will be a part of the broad spectrum of the National Education Policy-2020 to be implemented and adapted by all the stakeholders in the field of education, the IQAC of the college organized a seminar on **Outcome Based Education and NEP-2020** on 28th April, 2023 with an objective of introducing the faculty members in the colleges of cluster II of University of Mumbai, to the different facets of the policy to be implemented.

The seminar was inaugurated at the hands of the chief guest, Dr. Vinay P. Raut, Secretary, Vidya Vikas Education Society, the parent institution of the college. Dr. S. A. Aajgaonkar, the Principal of Sandesh College of Arts, Commerce & Science, Vikhroli was the guest of honour on this occasion. The chief guest, in his address, appealed to all the participants how it is the need of the hour for everyone to adapt to the qualitative changes expected in the field of education as the faculties would be the front runners who would display the real image of an educational institution.

The guest of honour thanked the IQAC and the Principal for providing an opportunity to the faculty members from the cluster II colleges to know about the different aspects of NEP-2020 by organizing the seminar.

Dr. Arvind Dhond, Head, Dept of Commerce, St. Xavier's College, Mumbai conducted the first technical session '**NEP-2020: Concepts and Issues**' wherein he explained the minute details of implementation of the policy at the level of higher education. Referring to various circulars from Govt of Maharashtra, he described how the policy would be implemented by the Government in different universities. Aspects like multidisciplinary approach, multiple entries and exits during a degree programme, the liberal approach to be adopted and so on were described in detail. He also emphasized how an active



It is expected that the guiding teacher should undertake the counselling sessions and make the awareness among the learners about the methodology of formulation, preparation and evaluation pattern of the project work.

- There are two modes of preparation of project work
 1. Project work based on research methodology in the study area
 2. Project work based on internship in the study area

Guidelines for preparation of Project Work

Work Load

Work load for Project Work is 01 (one) hour per batch of 15-20 learners per week for the teacher. The learner (of that batch) shall do field work and library work in the remaining 03 (three) hours per week.

I. General guidelines for preparation of project work based on research methodology

- The project topic may be undertaken in any area of Elective Courses.
- Each of the learner has to undertake a Project individually under the supervision of a teacher-guide.
- The learner shall decide the topic and title which should be specific, clear and with definite scope in consultation with the teacher-guide concerned.
- University/college shall allot a guiding teacher for guidance to the students based on her / his specialization.
- The project report shall be prepared as per the broad guidelines given below:
 - Font type: Times New Roman
 - Font size: 12-For content, 14-for Title
 - Line Space : 1.5-for content and 1-for in table work
 - Paper Size: A4
 - Margin : in Left-1.5, Up-Down-Right-1
 - The Project Report shall be bounded.
 - The project report should be 80 to 100 pages.

A brief overview of your experience and suggestions to bridge the gap between theory and practice.






