About The Spoken Tutorial

The Spoken Tutorial is a vital component of the "**Talk to a Teacher**" initiative under the **National Mission on Education through Information and Communication Technology (NMEICT)**. This initiative, launched by the Ministry of Education (formerly known as the Ministry of Human Resource Development, MHRD), Government of India, aims to promote widespread access to information technology education, empowering students with necessary skills in Free and Open Source Software (FOSS). The platform provides opportunities for learners across India to boost their employment potential by mastering various IT-related skills without any cost.

Key Features of The Spoken Tutorial Program

1.Free Access to Courses:

The platform offers a range of courses that are freely available to students. Through this initiative, Students of Vikas College can register for various IT courses, making quality education accessible to all.

2. Convenience and Flexibility:

- Courses are delivered through pre-recorded online video tutorials.
- Students can access the content at their convenience, anytime and from anywhere, making it ideal for self-paced learning.
- The recorded format allows learners to revisit lessons, helping them gain a better understanding of the material.

3. Certification Process:

- After registering through the college, students receive login credentials via email. These credentials allow them to access the platform and begin their courses.

- Upon completing a course, students are eligible for two types of certificates:

- **Participation Certificate:** Awarded without the need for any examination, this certificate is a mark of attendance and engagement.

- **Completion Certificate:** This certificate is awarded after passing an online exam, which is conducted at the college. A minimum score of 40% is required to obtain this certificate.

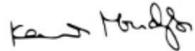
